Habit 7: Looking for ways to be Pro Active? Here are some things to focus on:

© Self-reflect; look at yourself and ask what you want to improve.

© Examine how you might perform these tasks more effectively.

© Work from the perspective of preventing problems from arising.

© Develop a mindset of working to solve a problem vs dwelling on it.

© Get and stay ahead of less urgent day to day tasks.

© Know which tasks are priorities and which can wait & eliminate unnecessary tasks.

Evaluate your procedures and processes as you use them.
 Assign tasks to people best suited for the task.

© Learn something just for the sake of learning something new, take up an interest.

Math & Fitness:

Give your child a chance to combine math practice & exercise with daily "math breaks". Give directions that include a math problem & a fitness activity. Ex: "Do 2+2 jumping jacks.

Exercise = Fun: Superman Exercise: Have child lie on their tummy with their arms straight out in front of them. Have them lift their arms & legs off the ground at the same time, & hold for 5 seconds.

Lastly, have them put their arms & legs back down. "Fly" 10 more times.
